Second Workshop Junkeri Program-Oral Hygiene


Make a Difference Nepal has successfully completed second workshop of Junkeri Program on Oral Hygiene. The program was organized on 08th of December, 2021. Because of the new rules and regulations imposed by the Health Ministry of Nepal after detecting 2 new covid-19 cases of omicron variant regarding operating face to face classes in school, only 25 students of Shree Setidevi Aadharbhut Vidayalaya participated on second workshop of Junkeri program. The second workshop Junkeri Program was delivered on the topic of Oral Hygiene. The area of topics covered in the oral

hygiene presentation were what is oral hygiene and why is it important, what type of tooth-brush is important, benefits of using tooth paste and tooth brush while brushing teeth, what is cavity/tooth decay, symptoms of tooth decay and proper way to brush your teeth. Make a Difference Nepal team created a pre-survey questionnaire form and a post-survey questionnaire form with a series of multiple choice questions (MCQ)s about various aspects of oral hygiene in order to assess the knowledge students at Shree Setidevi Aadharbhut Vidayalaya had prior to the program and what knowledge they gained after attending the second workshop oral hygiene program. Mr Sreeshant Karki actively volunteered and helped MDN team for the successful completion of the second month of Junkeri program. MDN team reached Shree Setidevi Aadharbhut Vidayalaya on 08th of December, 2021. In collaboration with the school management team, MDN arranged existing classroom as a workshop room and distributed pre and post questionnaire survey form accordingly to the program schedule. Mr. Krishna Thapa formally commence 2nd workshop of Junkeri program

by an introduction speech to all the participants about Junkeri Program and specifically 2nd month Junkeri Oral Hygiene program. After a opening introduction to all the participants by Mr. Krishna Thapa, MDN team then distributed the pre-survey form to all the students and Mr Pramod Basnet explained the questions in both Nepali and English language and MDN team as well as teachers of Shree Setidevi Aadharbhut Vidayalaya helped students understand the questions and tick on the answers which they find correct accordingly. MDN team recollected the pre-survey form. After that, Mr. Pramod Basnet delivered an presentation on “Oral Hygiene”.



After the end of presentation while concluding the slides by Mr. Pramod Basnet on Second workshop of Oral Hygiene program, MDN team distributed the post-survey form to all the participants of the program.

Participants after attending the presentation presented by Mr. Pramod Basnet, students gained a detailed knowledge regarding "Oral Hygiene, proper way to brush teeth, problems caused by tooth decay and ways to prevent it which could be analyzed in the "True or False" and "Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ)" answers which slightly varied from the pre-survey questions. After completion of fill up of post-survey form, Mr. Krishna Thapa concluded the session with a concluding speech.
